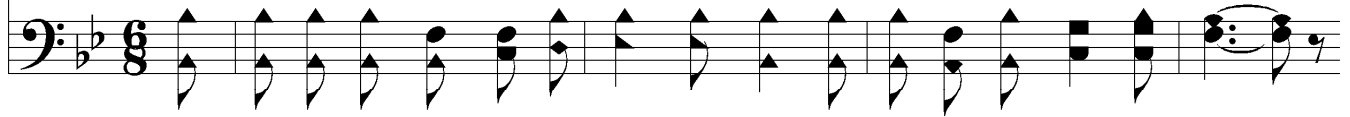


The Lord Is My Shepherd
