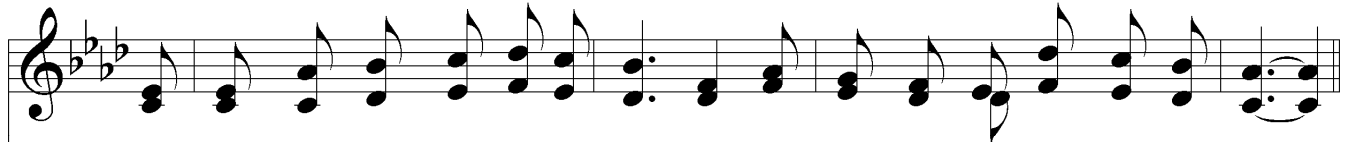


Go Forth To The Field
