

Humbly Now, With Deep Contrition

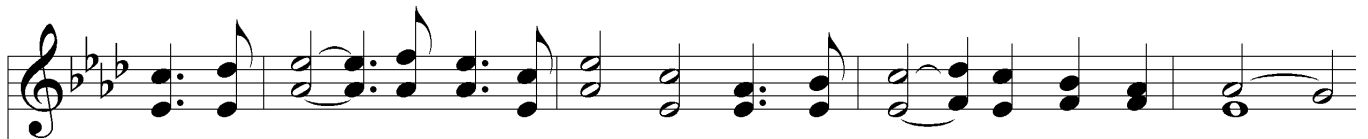
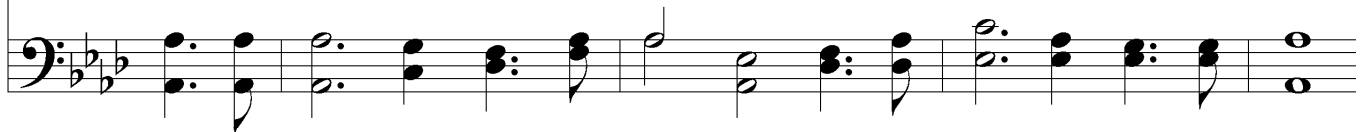
