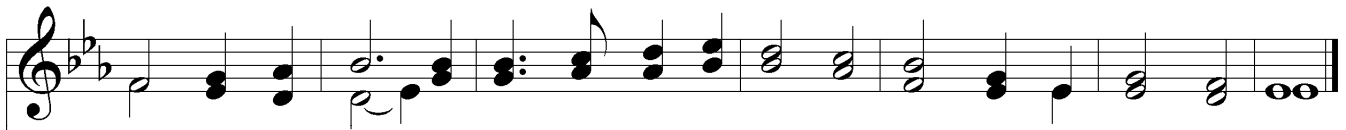
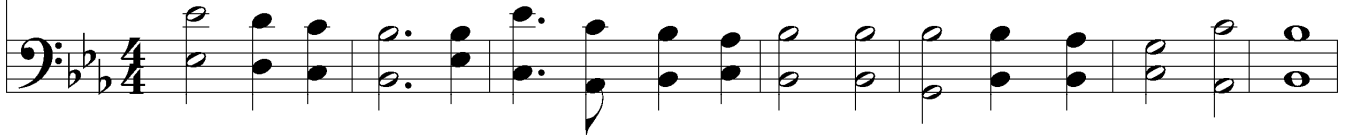


# Light Of The World
