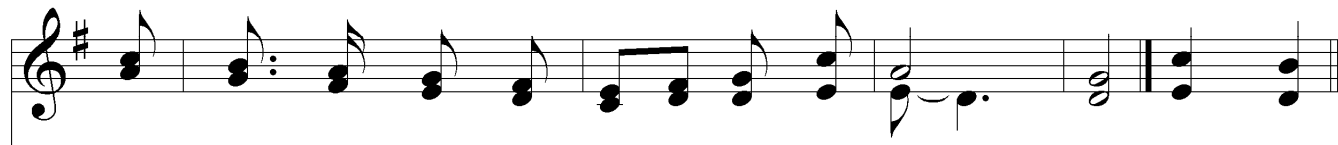
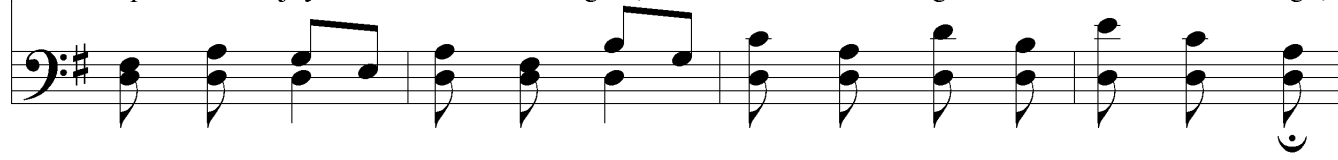
1. Sweet and clear the birds are sing - ing, At Eas - ter dawn.
