

What Must It Be To Be There?



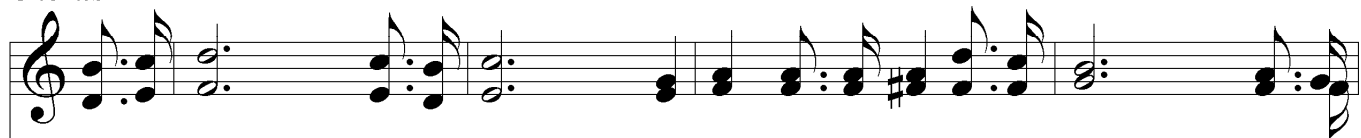
1. We speak of the land of the blest, A coun - try so bright and so fair,
