
1. Come, broth - ers and sis - ters who love one an - oth - er, And have done for years that are gone;

There was A - bra'm, and I - saac, and Ja - cob, and Da - vid, And Sol - omon, and Ste - phen, and John;


But we have such a wit - ness that God hears with swift - ness, From pray - ing we will not re - frain,
